Awards: Bachelor Degree (BSc)

Duration : Minimum time :

3 year (Full-Time) for BSc programme: 2 semesters per year totally 6 semesters. Every semester include 8 Modules and 2 seminars, totally for the three years 48 modules and 12 seminars.

Outline Delivery : The course is delivered in the afternoon 5:30 pm. to 9:30 pm. Typical time table are:

- Monday to Thursday for semester's programmes. Friday to Sunday for Seminars and Executive
- Programmes.

Typical Teaching Points :

- Every day Monday to Thursday in SBE classrooms are teaching 2 modules, 2 hours per module, totally 16 hours per teaching week.
- All participants should follow 4 procedures:1. Attendance of the modules.2. Studying of the modules.

 - One Coursework per module.
 Examination for all the modules per semester.
- The grading system is as follows: from the examinations 80%, and from the coursework 20%, totally 100%.

- Develop a strategy to choose appropriate technologies for competitive advantage.
- Develop a sound understanding of the law and associated operational procedures as related to operational safety and the protection of the marine environment.
- Effectively and efficiently plan and manage a research project.
- Be conversant with legal principles, law and conventions that apply to dry and wet shipping law.
